- Median values help to prevent unusually large or small data points (outliers) from skewing results.

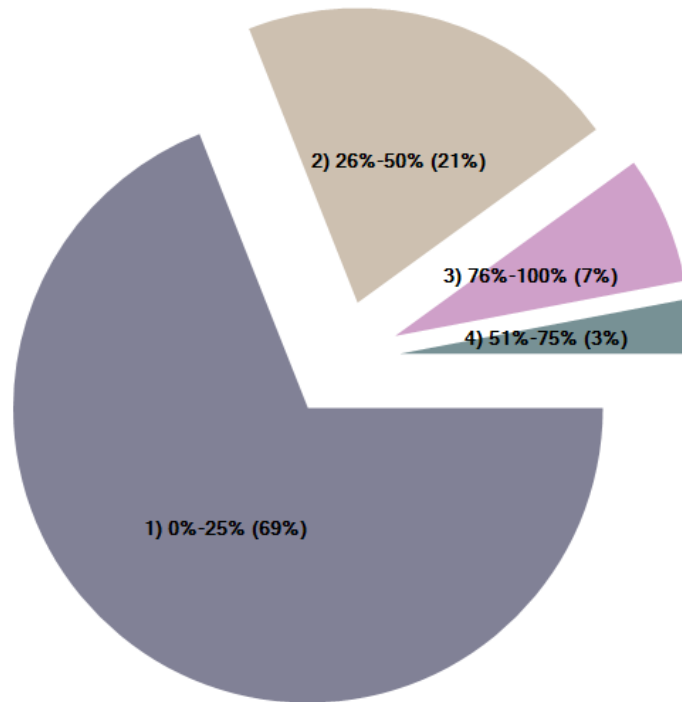
NUMERIC RESULTS:

MULTIPLE CHOICE RESULTS:

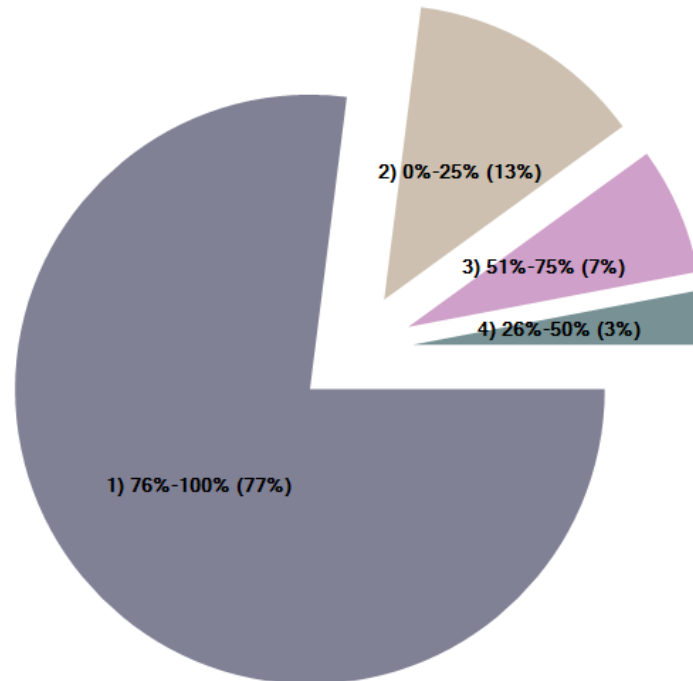
- The percentage of responses is shown for all answer options associated with a question.

How much has sales dropped compared to normal volume?



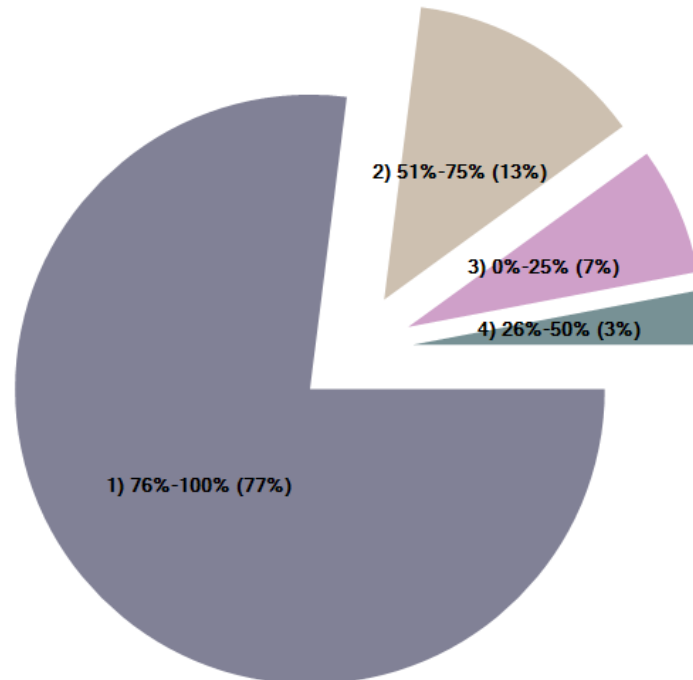

How much of your weekly work orders are you able to complete?



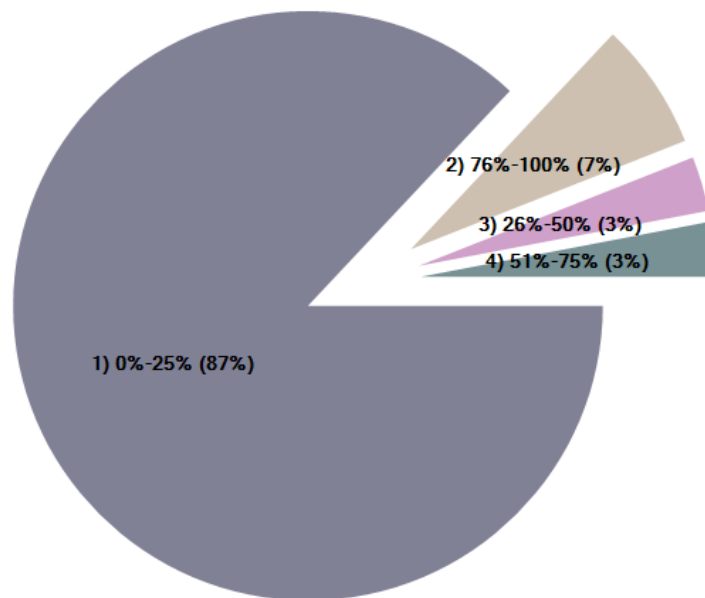

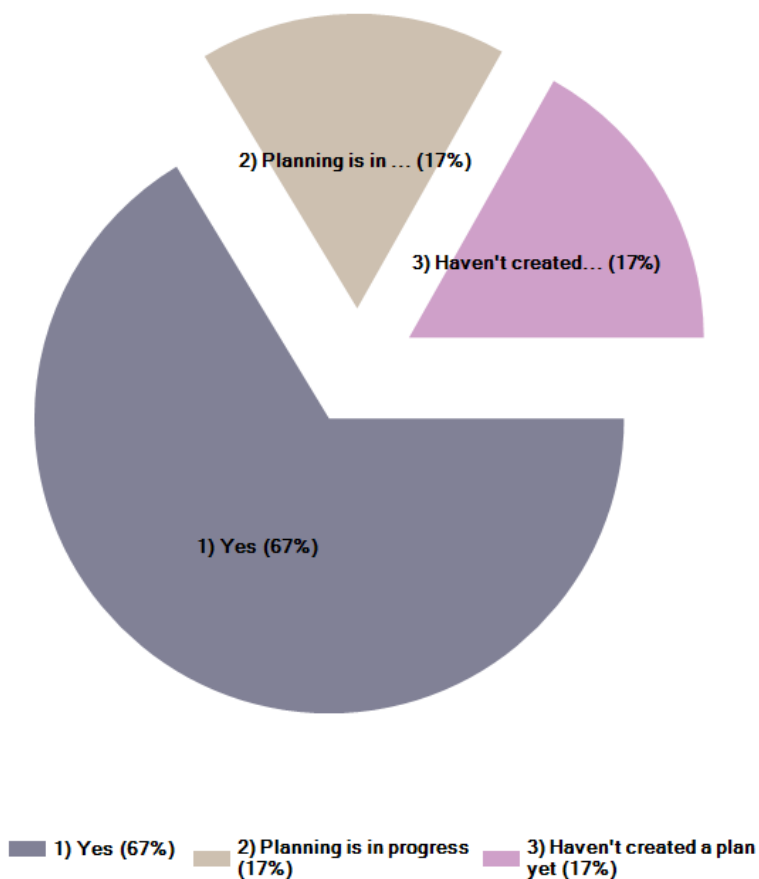

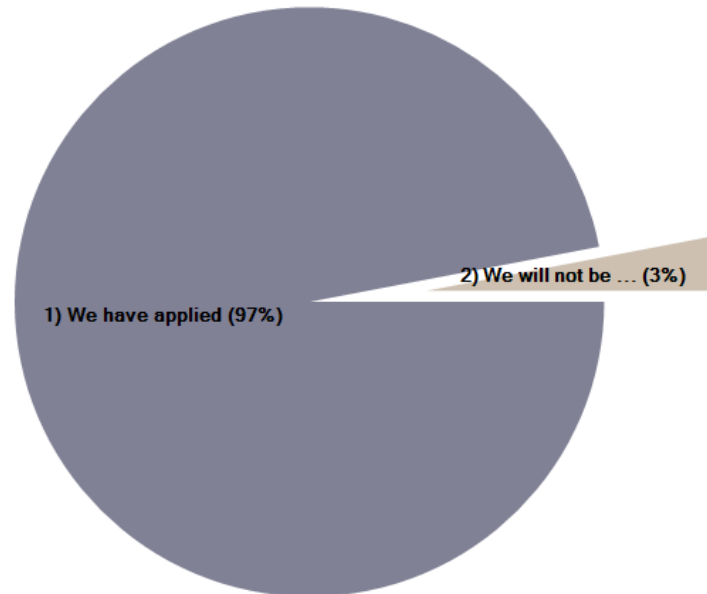

Have you developed a strategy for the new obligations under Families First Coronavirus Relief Act (FFCRA)?

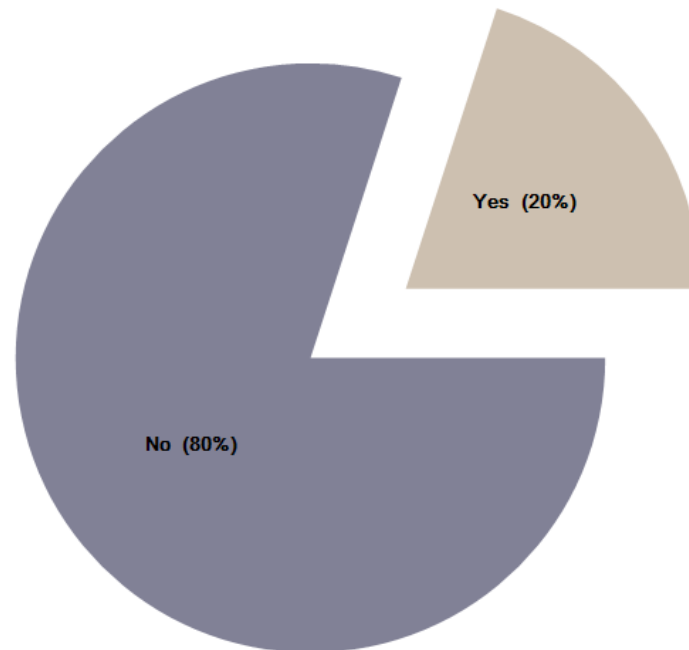


Have you applied for funding available through the new SBA program or other business aid programs?
